

Dr. Saver is SA Vice-Chair and Professor of Neurology at UCLA, and Director of the UCLA Comprehensive Stroke and Vascular Neurology Program. Author of over 670 research articles, 3 books, and 40 book chapters, Dr. Saver's major prevention research trials have included studies of PFO closure, cholesterol-lowering with PCSK9-inhibitors, and wearable detection of occult atrial fibrillation. He is currently Associate Editor at JAMA, the Journal of the American Medical Association, and Editorial Board Member at the journal Circulation, and is a recipient of both the Feinberg Award and the Distinguished Scientist Award from the American Heart Association/American Stroke Association.
