

Dr. Steven M. Greenberg is Professor of Neurology at Harvard Medical School, Vice Chair of Neurology for Faculty Development and Promotions, and John J Conway Endowed Chair in Neurology at Massachusetts General Hospital. Under Dr. Greenberg's leadership, the MGH Hemorrhagic Stroke Research Program has become internationally recognized for ground-breaking studies on the causes, diagnosis, and treatment of the major small vessel disease cerebral amyloid angiopathy. Dr. Greenberg serves as chair of the AHA 2021 guideline writing group on intracerebral hemorrhage, PI of the NIH-funded MarkVCID consortium for biomarkers of vascular cognitive impairment, and co-PI of the NIH-funded DISCOVERY network for post-stroke cognitive impairment and dementia, and is recipient of the 2017 AHA Feinberg award.
